Re: Authorization for Award A Bid from Siddons-Martin Emergency Group for the Acquisition of a Aircraft Rescue and Response Facility (ARRF) Foam Capable Fire Truck for use at McMahon-Wrinkle Airport

Staff is working with GEO Group to establish an Aircraft Rescue and Response Facility presence at McMahon-Wrinkle Airport to provide the ability to meet ARFF Inex "A" capabilities. This effort is necessary for the airport to be capable of flight operations associated with CRJ-200 aircraft, which are anticipated associated with a contract between GEO and the Federal Government.

The city received a bid from Siddons-Martin Emergency Group for a 2013 Oshkosh Stryker 4500 Foam Capable Fire Truck for use at McMahon-Wrinkle Airport

The lead time associated with this opportunity and the limited amount of available fire trucks meeting this capability make this an urgent need for the City of Big Spring Fire Department. And McMahon-Wrinkle Airport. A cost breakdown including foam supplies for the vehicle is as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BIG SPRING, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 024-2025 WHICH ADOPTED THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF BIG SPRING, TEXAS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2025 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2026 AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A 2013 OSHKOSH STRYKER 4500 ARFF (AIRCRAFT RESCUE AND FIRE FIGHTING) TRUCK AND THE NECESSARY FIREFIGHTING FOAM; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS the City Council adopted the annual 2025-26 budget for the City of Big Spring, Texas on September 23, 2025 (“Budget”); and

WHEREAS the urgency of this purchase is driven by the fact that three other municipalities have expressed interest in acquiring the same ARFF vehicle. Because of the limited supply of available ARFF apparatus and continued nationwide demand for these specialized units, there is a substantial risk that the vehicle will be sold to another purchaser if the City is unable to act promptly; and

WHEREAS the City Manager and the Finance Director recommend that the City Council increase the Airpark Fund budgeted expenditures and amend the Budget previously approved;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BIG SPRING, TEXAS, AS FOLLOWS THAT:

SECTION 1. The Airpark Fund Budget of the Annual Budget for the City of Big Spring, Texas for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2025 and ending September 30, 2026 is hereby increased by the amount of \$703,548.00.00 to account 410-021-610-6402-000 Fire Apparatus, for the purchase of a 2013 Oshkosh Stryker 4500 ARFF (Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting) truck and the necessary firefighting foam. The appropriation will be funded through the Fund Balance.

SECTION 2. The remaining portions of Ordinance Number 024-2025 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any purpose, the reminder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 5. The City Council hereby finds it necessary to pass this ordinance as an emergency measure in order to purchase this ARFF (Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting) Truck which is in high demand and has a very low inventory Unlike standard equipment purchases, ARFF vehicles are highly specialized and are manufactured by a limited number of vendors. New units typically require lengthy production schedules, and delays in securing an available vehicle could significantly extend the timeframe before a replacement unit can be obtained. The acquisition of the ARFF vehicle is necessary to provide the aircraft rescue and firefighting capabilities required for the City's pursuit of FAA Part 139 airport certification.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
