As a governmental body, the Big Spring City Council will not deliberate or take any formal action on any items discussed at this meeting.

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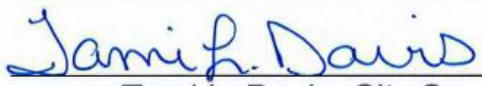
